When To Go to the ER:

Any life-threatening or disabling condition • Sudden or unexplained loss of consciousness
Infants under 6 weeks with fever of 100.4 or higher • Severe shortness of breath
High Fever with stiff neck, confusion or difficulty breathing • Coughing up or vomiting blood
Cut or wound that wont stop bleeding • Major injuries
